## Stay Healthy and Get a Flu Shot: 2017 Flu Immunization Options

There are several options available for Community Clinic patients and members this year:

**Community Clinic Pharmacy:** The vaccine is available beginning October 30<sup>th</sup> for those ages 9 years and older from our Pharmacy. Pharmacy staff encourage you to make an appointment by phoning 306-664-4277. Walk-in patients will also be accepted pending the Pharmacist's availability. You do not need to be a patient of a Community Clinic physician or Nurse Practitioner for this option.

**Downtown Clinic Patients:** The flu vaccination clinic for patients of Community Clinic doctors and nurse is scheduled for October 30 to November 9<sup>th</sup>, 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. This year's Clinic will take place at the Mel Langer Building, 424 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue North. After November 13, appointments can be made with the Appointment Nurse by phoning (306) 652-0300. Patients must be 6 months of age or older.

**Westside Clinic Patients:** Commencing October 23, patients of Westside Clinic doctors or nurse practitioners may drop in for influenza immunization anytime the Westside Clinic is open. Patients must be 6 months of age or older.
